Meetings are free and open to the public. You may attend all or part of the meeting, with the exception of executive sessions, which are closed to all but the Board of Directors.

The members of the Board of Directors serve as volunteers working for the betterment of the Sage International School, its students, and their parents.

Those wishing to address the Board of Directors must reside within the boundaries of Sage, be a student, be a parent/guardian of a student, be an employee of Sage, or be a representative of a firm eligible to bid on materials or services solicited by the Sage International School. Other people who wish to speak, but do not meet the above criteria, must receive permission from the Board Chair.

If you wish to provide testimony, please notify the Board, by email, 24-hours in advance of the meeting. In your message, please let us know on which of our agenda items you would like to be heard. All audience members giving testimony will be allowed the same amount of time to speak (2-5 minutes, depending upon the number of people present to speak about a given issue).
